- Keep in mind:
 - ✓ Different post-secondary pathways
 - ✓ Everyone has unique pathway
 - ✓ Distinction between diploma requirements and post-secondary pre-requisites
 - ✓ Grade 9-11 should be used for exploring and discovering likes, dislikes, talents, strengths, areas of need etc.
 - ✓ Grade 12 used to prepare for post-secondary
 - ✓ It's possible to change pathways
 - ✓ *Rare to be on a direct flight - expect lots of stopovers before you reach your destination*

Grade 10:

- ✓ 8 courses (5 compulsory, 3 elective)
- English
- Math
- Science
- Canadian History
- CIVCAR (Civics and Careers)
- Electives x 3 (choose courses in Groups 1 and 3 if possible)
 - ✓ Summer school not an ideal choice
 - ✓ Choose enrichments instead of summer school
 - ✓ Good time to establish study habits and work ethic

Grade 11:

- ✓ 8 courses (1 spare allowed, but students should start with 8)
 - English
 - Math (determines grade 12 mathematics pathways)
 - Electives x 6
- ✓ try new courses, expand your mind and options

Grade 12:

- ✓ 8 courses (2 spares allowed, but students should start with 8)
 - English
 - Electives x 7 (depending on post-secondary pathway pre-requisites)
- ✓ Students taking AFCALC must have 8 courses to start
- ✓ Research begins for post-secondary pathways now
- ✓ Post-secondary pathways need to be realistic and flexible

***Claude Watson students need to remember:**

- ✓ Grade 9 and 10 students take 9 courses not 8
- ✓ Must have 3 Art Electives (grades 9, 10 and 11)
- ✓ Cannot opt out of CW program and stay at EH if not home school
