

Triplets

A triplet is a group of three notes that are performed in the time normally allotted for two of the same kind of note:

$\text{Quarter note triplet} = 1 \text{ count}$

$\text{Half note triplet} = 1 \text{ count}$

$\text{Two quarter notes} = 2 \text{ counts}$

$\text{Half note triplet} = 2 \text{ counts}$
