NOTE AND REST VALUES

In most music the fundamental beat is assigned to the Quarter Note. If the Quarter Note gets one beat (count), then the following is true:

- QUARTER NOTE (♩) = 1 count
- HALF NOTE (♪) = 2 counts
- WHOLE NOTE (♩) = 4 counts
- EIGHTH NOTE (♩) = 1/2 count
- and
TWO EIGHTH NOTES (♪) = 1 count

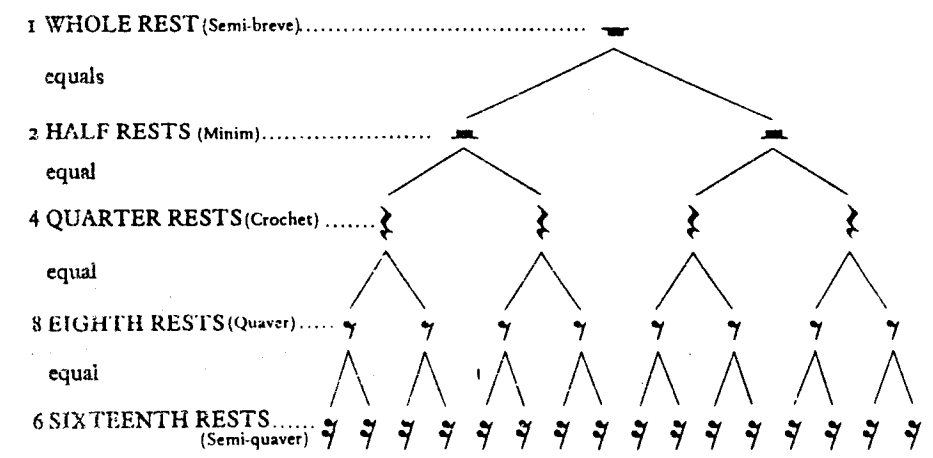
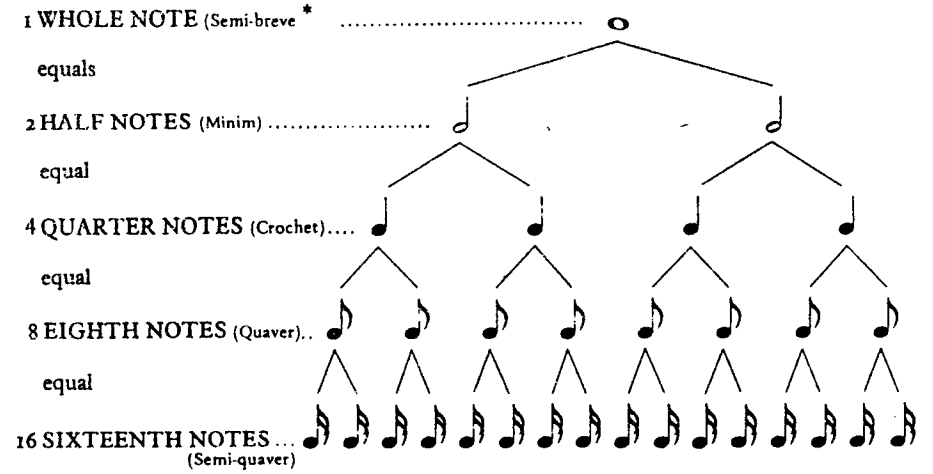
