INTERVALS

An interval is the distance between two notes. When the notes of an interval are played one after the other, the interval is called melodic.



When the notes of an interval are played at the same time, the interval is called harmonic.



All intervals have a specific number. This number is determined by counting the letter names of the notes in the interval from the lowest to the highest.



There are five letter names from C to G.

CDEFG 12345

This is an interval of a 5th.
