<b>Situation</b>	Saahir accused of passing fake \$20 bills
<b>Advocating Now: Pros</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• was able to convince manager he didn't know it was fake</li><li>• would look guilty if he walked away</li><li>• could explain where and how he got the bill</li><li>• knew to speak politely and not lose his cool</li></ul>
<b>Advocating Now: Cons</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• manager might not believe him, might get him into trouble</li><li>• wasn't able to ask for any advice</li><li>• didn't know if he could get his \$\$ back</li><li>• might blow up at the manager ... would make him look guilty!</li></ul>
<b>Now or Later? Why</b>	Advocate now because he can't walk away without looking guilty
<b>Partner's Response</b>	Agreed. Saahir had to tell his story immediately so it didn't look made up.
