## OUINFO.CA

- All Ontario University information
- Entrance to each program based on six, Grade 12U/M averages
- Earn a bachelor's degree
- Must have ENG4U1 as one of the six
- Programs list all necessary prerequisites along with minimum cut off grades for consideration

## ONTARIOCOLLEGES.CA

- All Ontario College information
- Entrance to each program based on Grade 12 English (U/C), some programs may have additional prerequisites
- Earn diploma or degree
- All degree programs will require six, grade 12U/M courses (lower cut-off grades than university)

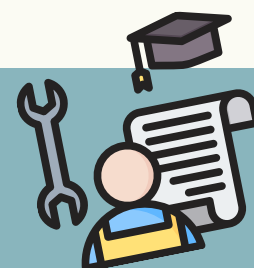

Information about apprenticeship pathway starting in high school

- 2 options: Accelerated OYAP or regular OYAP
- Can start as early as grade 11
- Must take COOP
