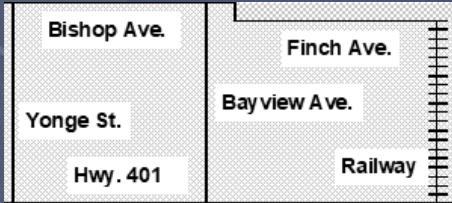

North Boundary

The hydro electric power corridor on the north side of Finch Ave. E. between Yonge St. and Bayview Ave., and Finch Ave. E. between Bayview Ave. and the CNR tracks on the west side of Leslie St.

South Boundary

Hwy. 401 between Yonge St. and the CNR tracks on the west side of Leslie St.

East Boundary

the CNR tracks on the west side of Leslie St. between Finch Ave. E. and Hwy 401

West Boundary

Yonge St. (odd numbers only) between the hydro electric power corridor on the north side of Finch Ave. E. and Hwy 401

grade 9 students

Grade 8 students who are currently living in residential buildings of more than 4 units within this area, built after December 2000 are not eligible to register for Earl Haig.

Grade 8 students currently enrolled in our feeder schools will follow the traditional registration procedures for admission to Earl Haig. Working closely with these schools, we will try to ensure that all in-area students have submitted a completed registration form by the due date, March 1st. Registration forms will be distributed through our feeder schools.

The final responsibility for meeting the deadline remains with the parent/guardian of the student applying for admission.

NEW TO THE AREA

GRADE 9 TO 12 STUDENTS

Students, who move into existing residential units within this area and who wish to apply for admission to grades 9 to 12, must produce a notarized agreement of purchase and sale OR a notarized lease, plus 2 additional proofs of residency.

Grade 9 to 12 students, coming from residential buildings of more than 4 units within this area built after December 2000, will be designated to Georges Vanier S.S.

STUDENTS MOVING OUT OF AREA

Students who move out of the area or into new developments mid-year and self-identify immediately to the office, may complete the balance of their academic year at Earl Haig, but must register at the home school in their new neighbourhood for the following September. It is the responsibility of the parent / guardian / student to inform the school if they are moving out of the area.

STUDENTS ENROLLED WHO ARE OUT OF AREA

TDSB will continue to undertake rigorous enrolment audits of students presently registered at Earl Haig Secondary School. Students discovered to be enrolled at Earl Haig S.S. without a legal right to attend, will be identified and directed to their local Secondary School.



- International students are not eligible to apply for this program.
- Admission to the Claude Watson Program is randomly selected by the Board.
- The program enrolment is capped.
- Students are welcome to apply in November through the TDSB website for Dance, Drama, Music, Film Arts and Visual Arts.
